Scripture Reading Before Invocational Prayer: St. Matthew 1: 23 Emmanuel God with us.

Scripture Lesson: St. John 1: 1 – 5, 14 The Word was God. The Word was made flesh.

Subject: JESUS CHRIST IS THE EXPRESSED IMAGE OF THE INVISIBLE GOD

Text: Colossians 1: 12 –19 Who is the image of the invisible God

Introduction: Hebrews 1: 1 – 8 The expressed image of God's person

Lesson Outline

1. Philippians 2: 6 Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:
2. St. John 5: 17 – 40 But Jesus answered them:
 - v17: Equal in Nature of their Being; v19: Equal in Works; v21: Equal in Power
 - v22: Equal in Authority; v23: Equal in Honor; v24: Equal in Truth
 - v25: Equal in Self-sustaining Giver of Life; v27: Equal in Judgment
 - v30: Equal in Justice over mankind
 - v36: Equal in works – Omnipotence, Omnipresent, Omniscient, Eternally Self Existence
 - v39: Equal in Testimony of all Scripture
 - v40: Equal in Deity, to be worthy to open the Book of Life.
3. Colossians 2: 9 – 10 For in Him dwelleth all the fullness of the Godhead bodily.
Fully God and Fully Man and came among us. **That's what Christmas is all about.**
4. St. John 11: 25 **I AM** the life or the self-existing one; (St. John 14: 6 **I AM** life, self-existing one.)
5. II Corinthians 4: 3 – 4 The light of Christ is the image of God.
6. II Corinthians 11: 4 If anyone preach another Jesus let him be accursed. (Galatians 1: 8 – 9)
7. St. John 17: 1 – 5 Glorify thou me with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.
