## The Third Person in the Trinity

Scripture Reading before Invocation Prayer: 1 Corinthians 12: 1-3

Scripture Lesson: Micah 3: 8 The Holy Spirit is Omnipotent.

## THE PERSON AND WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Text: Psalm 139: 7 - 12 The Holy Spirit is Omnipresent.

Introduction: I Corinthians 2: 9 – 16 The Holy Spirit is Omniscient (Revelation 5: 6 seven eyes..)

Lesson Outline – The Christian's Life can't be lived without the Holy Spirit.

- 1. Hebrews 9: 14 The Holy Spirit is Eternal.
- 2. Acts 1: 8 The Holy Spirit gives supernatural Power. (The Church is commanded to witness by the Power of the Holy Spirit or through the Holy Spirit's urging or guidance or prompting or reliance). When we go out witnessing, I am relying on the Holy Spirit. I'm depending on you.
- 3. II Corinthians 3: 17 18 Liberty in the Holy Spirit, transforms us toward Christ's glorious image.
- 4. St. John 16: 7 11 The Holy Spirit convicts or convinces the world of sin.
- 5. St. John 16: 13 16 The Holy Spirit magnifies Christ and will not speak of himself.
- 6. St. John 3: 5 7 The Holy Spirit gives life from the dead. (Titus 3: 5 renewing of the Holy Ghost)
- 7. Ezekiel 36: 25 27 The Holy Spirit indwells us with a new heart towards God.

(I Corinthians 6: 19 – 20)

- 8. St. John 15: 26 The Holy Spirit is sent from the Son and the Father and testifies of Christ.
- 9. St. Matthew 3: 11 The Holy Spirit Baptizes.

- 10. Acts 19: 1-7 The Holy Spirit Baptizes.
- 11. Galatians 5: 22 25 The Holy Spirit produces Fruit within a Christian; only the Spirit can do this.
- 12. Romans 8: 26 The Holy Spirit helpeth our infirmities by intercession of groanings.
- 13. Romans 8: 1 16 The Holy Spirit gives a victorious walk and bears witness with our spirit that we are the children of God. The Church today should FEAR whether or not they have the Holy Spirit!
- 14. Acts 16: 6 10 The Holy Spirit opens and shuts doors. (Colossians 4: 3; II Corinthians 2: 12; Acts 14: 27.
- 15. Ephesians 5: 16 The Holy Spirit fills us and we are commanded to be filled with the Holy Spirit.
- 16. Isaiah 63: 10 The Holy Spirit can be vexed or angered.
- 17. Ephesians 4: 29 32 The Holy Spirit can be grieved or saddened. (1) Corrupt communication (2) Bitterness (3) uncontrolled anger (4) unforgiveness.
- 18. St. Luke 12: 11 12 The Holy Spirit gives utterance.
- 19. Acts 5: 1 3, 9 The Holy Spirit can be lied to and tempted; You can't lie to a thing or a force.
- 20. Acts 7: 51 The Holy Spirit can be resisted.
- 21. Hebrews 10: 26 The Holy Spirit can be despised.
- 22. St. Matthew 12: 31 32 The Holy Spirit can be blasphemed, which there is no forgiveness.
