Scripture Reading before Invocation Prayer: St. John 3: 16

Scripture Lesson: St. John 15: 9 - 17 KEEP my commandments is to abide in ourselves and "Trustees" to deliver to others. A friend that sticketh closer than a brother (Proverbs 18: 24)

Subject: AS THE FATHER HATH LOVED ME, SO HAVE I LOVED YOU: CONTINUE YE IN MY LOVE. (St. John 15: 9) KJV

Introduction: I John 4: 7 - 17 The Love of God manifested toward us.

Lesson Outline

- 1. St. Matthew 18: 21 35
- 2. St. Matthew 7: 1-5 be not critical of thy brother but look after your own faults and shortcomings, for your spirit lust against the flesh and your flesh against the spirit.
- 3. Romans 14: 13 23 judge that you don't put a stumbling block in your brother's way
- 4. I Corinthians 8: 9 13 take heed that your liberty not become a stumbling block
- 5. Romans 12: 9-21 let love be without dissimulation (pretense, deceit, dishonesty, duplicity, lying, guile, faking, posturing, hypocrisy, two faced, etc.)
- 6. St. John 13: 34 35 a genuine relationship toward God will cause others to be drawn to God; a poor relationship toward God will cause us to be stumbling blocks.
- 7. Judges 17: 6 and 21: 25 every man did that which was right in his own eyes not the eyes of God
- 8. II Timothy 3: 1 8 Self love creates all the ills listed; a love for God creates righteousness.
- 9. Philippians 2: 12 13 God working in you to his will and good pleasure.
