TOPICS OF DISCUSSION

Discuss forming **corporate prayer** where all Church membership kneels in prayer, Sundays and Wednesdays at the same time. 7:30 on Wednesdays and 11: 00 on Sundays.

Discuss Face book viewing of previously recorded messages, **along with requesting a review of the latest lesson from each member. Discuss each member giving account of the scripture they wish to committee to memory.** Bro. & Sis. Bynoe to record the list of scripture quotations.

Discuss the offering collection and methods to take it up in light of ordinances that limit being out. Encourage the Church to remain faithful and diligent to reach our financial responsibilities.

Discuss a weekly newsletter to include the sick list, birthdays, encouragements, percentage of collection needed to keep church running, and word from the Pastor, etc. Have it placed on Church website.

Discuss transferring our funds in First National Bank Bastrop into an interest-bearing account similar to a money market. Etc., leaving a minimum amount to keep account open.

Discuss clean up teams continuing to come to the church weekly and Sanitizing and maintain a sterile environment and presence. Discuss obeying all of man's laws and continuing with social distancing and hand washing and all preparation to slow the spread of coronavirus.

Discuss supporting the Church in Punta Gorda with lessons and additional financial support where needed. An additional \$50.00 US (\$100.00 BZ) was sent this month—however, Bro. James Duncan is out of work and is one who needs our support. Send instruction to have each member view the recorded messages and assist the ones who don't have proper connections. Have each member committee scripture to memory.

Discuss repairing the small bus transmission to prepare to sale and remove from front of Church before it deteriorates too much and not of use to anyone.

Discuss preparations to have our 2019 Easter program place on website, along with the Gospel Message and invitation. Discuss possible advertising of Easter/Passover program on e-mail blast, other viable methods. [Discuss the streaming license needed to place songs on Facebook.](#)

Discuss the entire Church going on a three day fast for Easter, beginning on Friday.

Discuss general Church advertising during this pandemic to give hope to hearting hearts.

Discuss teams of ten brothers or less continue coming to the Church to keep the landscape, flower beds, etc. in shape. Discuss purchasing the necessary shrubs to replace dead and dying ones.

Discuss the purchasing of video cameras for the back of the Church as well as in the hall ways.

Discuss Prayer-peration to assist the needy and less fortunate saints, as well as the way to go about checking on them.

Discuss coating the front porch and the possible ways and their cost.

Discuss õpaintingö the four front pillars in white paint and perhaps adding texture.

Discuss possibility in the future of having house meetings with ten saints or having parking lot services where all stay in their cars and a PA system broadcasting singing and prayer and proclamation.

Discuss purchasing New Carpet for the Sanctuary.

Discuss getting necessary care to the Babes and the Childrenø Church.

Discuss singles prayer partnering which is currently being done.

Discuss the video õBiggest Deception on the whole world endgame planö and its relevance with what we know about the end times and approaching one world ruler.

Covid-19: What you can do right now to stay safe

How to stay safe where you live

“Based on the information received so far, and on our experience with other coronaviruses, COVID-19 appears to spread mostly through respiratory droplets (when a sick person coughs, for example) and close contact,” a WHO spokesperson told *Medical News Today*. In light of that information, the spokesperson said, the WHO recommends preventive actions to minimize exposure to droplets.

During day-to-day activities, people can take the following measures to prevent infection, in accordance with WHO guidelines:

Clean the hands regularly with an alcohol-based sanitizer, or wash them with soap and water. [The CDC](#) also make this recommendation, advising that sanitizer should contain “at least 60% alcohol” and that people should wash their hands for at least 20 seconds.


1. Clean surfaces — such as kitchen seats and work desks — regularly with disinfectant.
2. Avoid crowded areas when going out, for people over 60 years old and people with any underlying health problems.
3. Try to avoid close contact with people who display flu-like symptoms, including coughing and sneezing.

Get accurate information about COVID-19. Some good sources include the [Pan American Health Organization](#) and [WHO](#) websites.

The [American Red Cross](#) also advise against touching the mouth, nose, or eyes when out and about, before having a chance to wash the hands.
