Sunday Lesson

April 26, 2020

Repent for we all are Perishable Goods

Scripture reading before Invocation Prayer: Acts 2: 36 – 41 Repent and be baptized.

Scripture Lesson: St. Matthew 21: 28 – 46 whether of the twain did the will of the father?

Subject: **FOR GOD SO LOVED THE WORLD THAT HE GAVE HIS ONLY
BEGOTTEN SON THAT WHOSOEVER BELIEVETH IN HIM SHOULD
NOT PERISH, BUT HAVE EVERLASTING LIFE.** (St. John 3: 16)KJV

Text: St. Luke 19: 1 – 10 Repent of the Bad things we have done: Broken God's Laws.

Introduction: Philippians 3: 1 – 12 Repent of the Good things you have done in your life.

Isaiah 64: 6 all our righteousness are as filthy rags – repent of the good for even it falls short.

Romans 3: 23 says: all have sinned and come short of the glory of God. (II Corinthians 5: 21)

Lesson Outline

Repentance must include a God dimension, not regret or remorse

1. II Corinthians 7: 8 – 11 Godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation
2. St. Luke 15: 11 – 24 Prodigal son sinned toward Heaven, not regret or remorse: Came to himself. (Joseph and Potiphar's wife: Genesis 39: 9 he did not want to sin against God.)
3. Isaiah 55: 6 – 11 forsake his way and let him return unto the Lord
4. St. Luke 13: 1 – 9 except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.
5. II Peter 3: 8 – 9 not willing that any should perish
6. St. Matthew 5: 13 *Repentance is a preservative for perishable souls/goods*
7. St. Luke 14: 34 – 35 If salt have lost his savor, it is no longer fit but is cast out.
8. Acts 26: 13 – 20 Repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance
9. St. Matthew 3: 1 – 12 bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance
10. Acts 17: 18 – 34 commands all men everywhere to repent
11. Ezekiel 3: 16 – 21 The watchman must deliver his soul and those that hear him
12. St. Luke 24: 44 – 53 that repentance and remission of sins should be preached to all nations.
13. Ecclesiastes 12: 13 – 14 Let us hear the conclusion, fear God and keep His commandments.

REPENTANCE INVOLVES:

Change of mind – think God’s way, the higher we see God, the lower we see ourselves

Word of Repentance – Confess particular sins. The worst thing you ever did; the things that I never told anyone. **It was my fault, I did it.** We are the results of **what we have done**, to what’s been done to us. It’s the choice of our reaction to what was done to us that has made us who we are. The basic need of mankind is not healing from things we have done, but forgiveness of things we have done that make it possible for God to forgive us. I made the wrong choice and I’m, responsible. (I John 1: 9; James 5: 16; St. Matthew 3: 6) To renounce the world, the flesh, and the devil.

Deeds – produce fruit worthy of repentance and I will baptize you (St. Matthew 3: 8) if you are doing wrong – stop; be content with your wages. Prove repentance by your deeds. Putting the past right. (St. Luke 19: 8 Zacchaeus said “I will restore him.”) cutting the umbilical cord that ties you to Satan. (Acts 19: 19 Many burned their books of curious arts, religion, cults, secret societies) Burn all your bridges to the world (I John 2: 15 – 17, St. Luke 14: 31 – 33, he who does not forsake all that he has cannot be my disciple)

We must help them to repent – Galatians 6: 1, yea which are spiritual restore in the spirit of meekness.

James 5: 19 – 20 he that converteth the sinner shall save a soul from death and hide a multitude of sins.

Help them be serious – Fear of God beginning of wisdom (Proverbs 9: 10), Fear Him who can destroy body and soul in hell (St. Matthew 10: 28), It is a Fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. (Hebrews 10: 31)

Keep their confidence and search out particular sins, worse sin, guide them, list of sins.

They need Revelation to show them their worse or the Holy Spirit shows us their worse.

Be sensible, you can’t correct all things but use common sense. The Just shall live by faith.
