A NEW HEART

Scripture Reading before Invocation Prayer: Jeremiah 13: 23 can the Ethiopian change his skin?

Scripture Lesson: I Samuel 16: 1 – 13 (Psalm 78: 70 – 72) from feeding sheep to feeding Israel

Subject: **FOR THE LORD SEETH NOT AS MAN SEETH; FOR MAN LOOKETH ON THE OUTWARD APPEARANCE, BUT THE LORD LOOKETH ON THE HEART.** I Samuel 16: 7 (KJV)

Text: II Corinthians 10: 1 – 11 Paul's authority questioned because of his physical presence and speech.

Introduction: Isaiah 55: 8 – 9 My thoughts are not your thoughts, your ways not my ways.

Lesson Outline

1. Jeremiah 17: 9 – 10 The heart is deceitful above all things and desperately wicked.
2. Proverbs 4: 23 out of the heart comes the issues of life. (Psalm 14: 1) The fool has said in his heart there is no God for me, or No to God.
3. St. Matthew 15: 1 – 20 for out of the heart proceeded things that defile a man.
4. St. Matthew 12: 34 – 37 out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.
5. I John 3: 11 – 21 if our hearts condemn us not then have we confidence toward God.
6. Ezekiel 36: 24 – 28; Psalm 51: 1 – 13 create in me a clean heart; St. John 3: 3 Born Again; Titus 3: 5 washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Ghost.
7. Acts 8: 26 – 39 Philip and the Ethiopian eunuch. If thou believe with all thy heart thou mayest be saved. Romans 10: 9 – 10 for with the heart man believed righteousness.
