## **GOD'S "RIGHTS"**

Scripture Reading before Invocation Prayer: I Samuel 15: 22 – 23 Reverence of Obedience

Scripture Lesson: Micah 6: 1 - 8 God's "right" to Require of His creation.

Subject: HE HATH SHEWED THEE, O MAN, WHAT IS GOOD; AND WHAT DOETH THE LORD REQUIRE OF THEE, BUT TO DO JUSTLY, AND TO LOVE MERCY, AND TO WALK HUMBLY WITH THY GOD.

Micah 6: 8 (KJV)

Text: Hosea 6: 4-7 & Hosea 12: 1-6 "I desired Mercy and the knowledge of God"

Introduction: St. John 17: 1 - 3 To Know God IS eternal life.

God has not shown man how to comprehend all the frustrating vanities and purposes of life, but instructs us to enjoy life as a gift Ecclesiastes 2: 24; to make the most of every opportunity Ecclesiastes 9: 10; and to live life with a reverence toward Himself; accompanied by an awareness of future judgement Ecclesiastes 12: 14.
