Rehearse and be prepared to give Testimony of the time in your life when there was a "*crushing*" of your will, and the mortifying of your flesh; conforming you to the will of God by the Holy Spirit.

For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son,... (Romans 8: 29)

Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry: For which things sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience: (Colossians 3: 5 - 6)

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, (Crushing your will) that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. (Romans 12: 1-2)

Rehearse and be prepared to give Testimony of the time in your life when you were offended and had a struggle with forgiveness; but by God's grace and mercy and longsuffering, you were able to overcome and gain victory over Sin, temptation and the devil. You thereby free others as well as yourself.

For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses. (St. Matthew 6: 14 - 15)

Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee; Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift. (St. Matthew 5: 23 - 24)

And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: He shall glorify me: (St. John 16: 8, 13, 14)
