he Cross is one of the most recognized symbols in the Bible. It is the most recognized in the New Testament scriptures. It was prophesied long before that our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, would give His life for the sins of many on a cross. This type of death is called a crucifixion. What made this part of the prophecy stand out is that Christ was born a Jew. His ministry took him around Galilee and surrounding areas but his death was not Jewish, it was Roman. The Romans did not invent crucifixion. It was used systematically by the Persians in the 6th century BC. Alexander the Great brought it from there to the eastern Mediterranean countries in the 4th century BC, and the Phoenicians introduced it to Rome in the 3rd century BC. 
Holy Week begins Palm Sunday and Passover (Easter)
