Scripture Reading before Invocation Prayer: Ephesians 4: 1 – 7 Unity of the Spirit, bend...

Scripture Lesson: St. Matthew 12: 22 – 28

Subject: **EVERY KINGDOM DIVIDED AGAINST ITSELF IS BROUGHT TO DESOLATION; AND EVERY CITY OR HOUSE DIVIDED AGAINST ITSELF SHALL NOT STAND:**

(St. Matthew 12: 25) KJV

Text: St. Matthew 12: 29 – 30 the Gospel of Christ overthrows the kingdom of Satan

Introduction: St. Matthew 12: 33 – 37 “**Tongue Sins**” (1) Blasphemy of the Holy Ghost: Vs. 31, 32;
(2) Words spoken from a corrupt heart: Vs. 33 – 35; (3) Idle words: Vs. 36 – 37 vain, trifling, unprofitable

Lesson Outline

1. St. Matthew 12: 31 – 32 **Sin of Blasphemy** – attributing the Person of the Holy Spirit’s work to that of Satan, Sin against God the spirit’s name, character, and authority, bullheaded, pigheaded, stubborn, self-willed, sticking to your own ideas and desires. Leads to a refusal to repent because the truth is hidden from your dark heart and leaves you separated from God. Not that God’s mercy and Grace can’t reach you, but you are unable to receive it.

St. Matthew 12: 31 – 32 Blasphemy of the Holy Ghost (cf. St. Luke 12: 10)

Acts 5: 3, 4, 9 Lying or tempting the Holy Ghost

Hebrews 10: 26 – 29 Despising the Holy Ghost

Acts 7: 51 Resisting or striving with the Holy Ghost (cf. Genesis 6: 3)

Isaiah 63: 10, Ephesians 4: 30 Vexing and grieving the Holy Spirit

I Thessalonians 5: 19 Quench not the Spirit.

2. I Corinthians 1: 10 – 13 that here be no divisions among you. “In the principles of the faith, be of one mind. Where there is not a unity of opinions and views, let there be a union of affection and self-denial to keep Christ and others first.” Pride is at the heart of all contentions.
3. James 3: 13 – 18 envy and strife opens the door to every evil work.
4. Ephesians 4: 30 – 32 forgiving one another, even as God hath forgiven you.
5. Romans 16: 17 – 18 mark them that cause division and offences.
6. Galatians 5: 14 – 16 take heed that ye be not consumed one of another
7. Colossians 3: 12 – 15 Governed by Peace, bonded by Charity.
