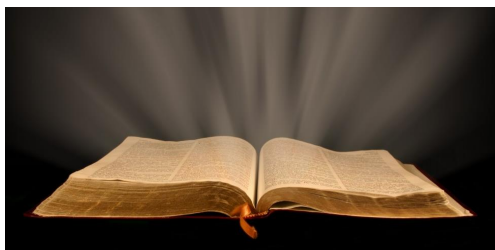




Our Hope in Christ Coming

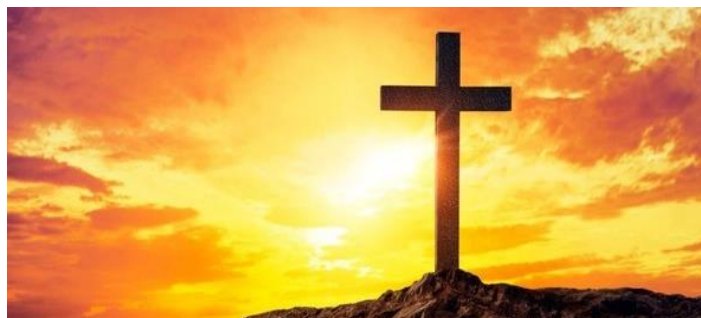
that where I am, there ye may be also. And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know.

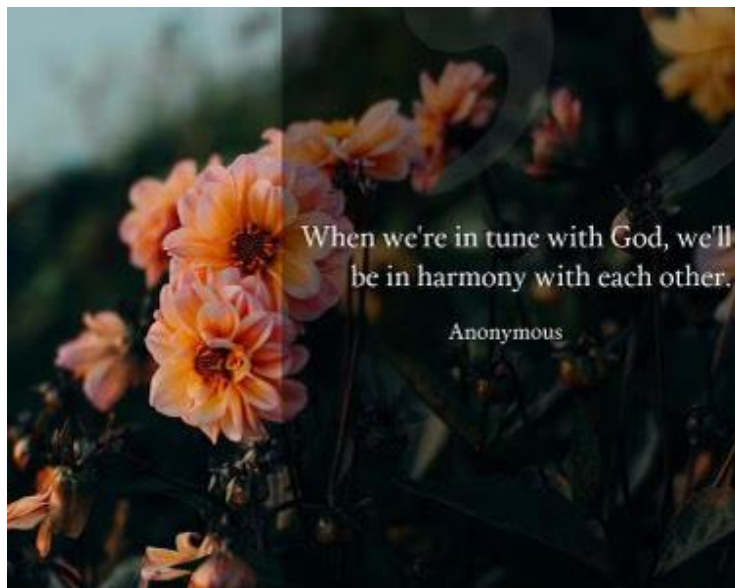
(1 Thessalonians 5:8-11 KJV)
