Scripture Lesson: Psalm 1: 1-6

Subject: FOR THE LORD KNOWETH THE WAY OF THE RIGHTEOUS: BUT THE WAY OF THE UNGODLY SHALL PERISH. (Psalm 1: 6) KJV

Text: Psalm 2: 1-7 Why do people reject and plot against Christ?

Introduction: II Corinthians 5: 21 Jesus took our sins and gave us His righteousness.

Lesson Outline

The "righteous" have a conviction about their sins and troubled enough to come to the one who can heal them. The ungodly do not care about sin and think it unimportant to be concerned with sin.

1. St. Luke 18: 9 - 14 two men went into the temple to pray.

2. Romans 10: 1-3 self-righteousness is the deceiving power of the devil.

3. Philippians 3: 7 - 11 righteousness of God by faith.

4. I Peter 4: 17 - 19 nothing but the righteous shall see God.
