Scripture Reading before Invocation Prayer: St. John 14: 1 -6

Scripture Lesson: St. John 11: 1 – 53 Does your faith make Jesus sad? (cf. St. Luke 19: 41 – 47)

Subject: **I AM THE RESURRECTION, AND THE LIFE: HE THAT BELIEVETH IN ME, THOUGH HE WERE DEAD, YET SHALL HE LIVE: AND WHOSOEVER LIVETH AND BELIEVETH IN ME SHALL NEVER DIE. BELIEVEST THOU THIS?** (St. John 11: 25 – 26) KJV

Text: St. John 4: 1 – 26, 39 – 42 (cf. St. John 7: 37 – 39 out of his belly flow living water) (cf. St. Matthew 10: 5 – 6, Go not into the way of the Gentiles) (cf. Acts 10: 28, 34-35 of a truth God is no respecter of person)

Introduction: St. Matthew 22: 23 – 32 Sadducees say there is not resurrection (cf. Acts 23: 6 – 10)

1. I Corinthians 15: 12 – 23, 35 – 37, 42 – 44 how say some among you there be no resurrection
2. Acts 24: 14 – 15 both of the just and the unjust (cf. Daniel 12: 1 – 2)
3. St. John 5: 24 – 29 resurrections of life and resurrection of damnation.
4. Romans 14:12 every one must give account of himself to God
5. Acts 4: 1 – 12 Sadducees grieved teaching the resurrection from the dead. (cf. Philippians 3: 21)
6. Acts 17: 22 – 34 assurance by the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.
7. Revelation 20: 4 – 6 This is the first resurrection
8. Revelation 20: 11 – 15 This is the second resurrection
