Scripture Reading before Invocation Prayer: St. John 6: 28 – 29 merit verses obedience

Scripture Lesson: James 2: 14 – 26 What are your fruits of Faith? (cf. Romans 4:1 – 25, Hebrews 11:31)

Subject: BUT WILT THOU KNOW, O VAIN MAN, THAT FAITH WITHOUT WORKS IS DEAD?

James 2: 20 (KJV)

Text: Galatians 5: 1-6 not merit or work of the law, but faith that worketh by love.

Introduction: I Thessalonians 1: 1 – 3 remembering your work of faith (cf. Ephesians 2: 8 – 10)

Lesson Outline

- 1. St. Matthew 5: 13 16 that men may see your good works and glorify your father in heaven.
- 2. St. John 15: 1-8 he that abided in me the same bringeth forth much fruit.
- 3. St. Matthew 13: 18 23 fruit bearing faith
- 4. St. Matthew 25: 31 46 a faith that works and one that does not work
- 5. I John 3: 7 10 living faith that saves and dead faith that does not
- 6. Romans 2: 6 10 the fruit of our labor

FAITH is the root; good works are the fruit of faith. Dead Faith is void of proof of spiritual life, and bears no fruit; disqualifying us from eternal life.
