ADULTS

The Idolatry of Self

Scripture Reading before Invocation Prayer: St. Luke 9: 23 – 26

Scripture Lesson: Acts 14: 8 – 18 (cf. Romans 1: 18-20, Romans 2: 14 – 15) (cf. Acts 8: 9 – 11, 28: 1 – 7)

Subject: **WE SHOULD BE VERY CAUTIOUS THAT WE DO NOT GIVE THAT GLORY TO ANOTHER; OR RECEIVE IT OR ALLOW IT TO OURSELVES, WHICH IS DUE TO GOD ALONE.**

Text: Acts 12: 21 – 23 smote because he gave not God the glory.

Introduction: Daniel 4: 4 – 37 I built, my might, for my honor

Lesson Outline

1. Revelation 22: 8 – 9 (cf. Colossians 2: 18) Angels won't allow themselves to be worshiped.
2. II Timothy 3: 1 – 8 Lovers of self, a characteristic of the last days
3. Isaiah 14: 12 – 15 I will be like the most High (cf. II Thessalonians 2:4)
4. St. Matthew 4: 8 – 10 Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.
5. Psalm 115: 1 – 8 not unto us but unto thy name give glory

Narcissism = excessive interest or admiration of oneself, or one's physical appearance, selfishness, involving a sense of entitlement. A disorder characterized by an inflated sense of self-importance.

Scripture Lesson: I Corinthians 10: 16 – 22 partaking in things sacrificed to idols joins us to the idol; even as partaking of the Lord's Supper joins us to Christ.

Subject: **BUT I SAY, THAT THE THINGS WHICH THE GENTILES SACRIFICE, THEY SACRIFICE TO DEVILS, AND NOT TO GOD: AND I WOULD NOT THAT YE SHOULD HAVE FELLOWSHIP WITH DEVILS.** (I Corinthians 10: 20) KJV

Text: I Kings 18: 19 – 40 Elijah and the prophets of Ba'al

Introduction: Psalm 115: 1 – 8 (you become like the god you serve)

Lesson Outline

1. Isaiah 44: 8 – 18
2. Psalm 106: 19 – 24 (cf. Romans 1: 23) change the glory into an image like fourfooted beasts.
3. Psalm 97: 6 – 7 Confounded be all they that serve graven images and idols.
4. Acts 17: 16 – 34 "TO THE UNKNOWN GOD"
