Lesson Outline

Treasure is a Stewardship of the Christian life:

- 1. I Corinthians 16: 2 (**PRIORITY GIVING**) Upon the first day of the week have a plan, do it routinely, do it reverently, a priority of honoring God. "A ritual of righteousness" "Giving is a discipline of life" "Money is your time and your talent converted into currency"
- 2. I Corinthians 16: 2 (**PERSONAL GIVING**) Let every one of you lay by him in store Personal for each one is to give
- 3. I Corinthians 16: 2 (**PROPORTIONAL GIVING**) As God hath prospered him find a basis to start from, then give as the Lord has prospered. When your income increases don't increase your living but rather increase your giving. Riches can be a blessing or a burden.
- 4. I Corinthians 16: 2 (**PURPOSEFUL GIVING**) that there be no gathering when I come purpose so they don't have to have special offerings when he comes. Put it in a regular offering to eliminate multiple offerings.
- 5. I Corinthians 16: 3 giving liberally to help the less fortunate.
- 6. II Corinthians 8: 1 24 Proof of your love first gave their own selves to the Lord.
- 7. II Corinthians 9: 6 15 Cheerful giving Law of sowing and reaping Proverbs 19: 17, Ecclesiastes 11: 1
