Take No Thought means – to not be anxious; to be so disturbed about material needs that we distrust God, and are distracted from faithfully doing His Will. This state of anxiety is related to being "O ye of little faith". Anxious care is distrustful unbelieving thoughts and is the direct opposite of faith. When our priority is spiritual God takes care of the material. When God guides, He provides.
