"To Whom will you liken me"

Scripture Reading before Invocation Prayer: Romans 8: 28 – 30 for whom he did foreknow

Scripture Reading: Isaiah 46: 1 - 13 The God of the Bible finishes a thing first; then He begins it!

Subject: I AM GOD, AND THERE IS NONE ELSE; I AM GOD AND THERE IS NONE LIKE ME, DECLARING THE END FROM THE BEGINNING.

(Isaiah 46: 9 – 10) KJV

Text: Psalm 115: 1 - 8 trust in God not in Idols, who knows the end from the beginning.

Introduction: Psalm 135: 5 - 18 Trust not in Idols. (cf. 1 Corinthians 10: 20, Isaiah 44: 9 - 30, Jeremiah 10: 1 - 16)

Jonah 2: 8 Those that cling to idols turn away from God's love for them.

- Revelation 5: 1 10 Lamb of God slain and resurrected before the foundation of the world. St. John 1: 29 Lamb of God which taketh away the sin of the world.
 1 Peter 1: 18 – 21 a Lamb foreordained before the foundation of the world. (cf. Acts 2: 22-24) Isaiah 53: 5 – 7 as a sheep before her shearers, he opened not his mouth Revelation 13: 8 the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world
- 2. Jeremiah 1: 4-5 before I formed thee in the belly, I know thee. (cf. Psalm 139 13 16)
- 3. Genesis 45: 1 7 & Genesis 50: 20 What you meant for evil God meant it for good
- 4. Revelation 4: 1 11 saints of God casting crowns before the throne, in eternity.
- 5. Ephesians 1: 1–12 predestinated and chosen before the foundation of the world. (cf. Ephesians 2:10)
