Scripture Reading Before Invocation Prayer: St. Matthew 11: 28 – 30 The invitation

Scripture Lesson: James 1: 19 – 27 swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath!

Subject: **BLESSED ARE THE MEEK: FOR THEY SHALL INHERIT THE EARTH.**

(St. Matthew 5: 5) KJV

Introduction: I Peter 2: 17 – 23 **Do well and suffer for it.** When He was reviled he reviled not again

Lesson Outline

The Meek are those who quietly submit to God and are gentle toward all men (Titus 3: 1 – 6) The Meek have the constitution and conviction and can bear being provoked and not be angry, and who will be silent or return a soft answer. They can be cool when others are hot. The Bible says “In your patience possess ye your souls” (St. Luke 21: 19). The Meek take possession of their own souls and would rather forgive 7 times 70 than to take vengeance one time (Romans 12: 17 – 20). But the fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. And they that are Christ’s have crucified the flesh (Pride and Ego) with the affections and lusts. (Galatians 5: 22 – 23) The Meek are blessed with a comforting spirit, and a not easily disturbed peace and confidence of themselves and the God they serve.

The women of God should strive to possess a meek and quiet spirit, which in the sight of God is of great price. (I Peter 3: 1 – 12) (cf. Proverbs 31: 25 – 30 strength and honor are her clothing)

Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth. (Numbers 12: 1 – 3 ...) The Bible says that the Lord lifteth up the meek: he casteth the wicked down to the ground (Psalm 147: 6). Furthermore, God resisteth the proud and giveth grace to the humble. (James 4: 6)

The spirit of Meekness should guide the Pastor when dealing with souls (II Timothy 2: 24 – 26, Galatians 6:1 – 2). **The spirit of Meekness** should guide us in our witnessing (I Peter 3: 15 – 18)

The Meek have a blessedness on Earth and are promised a blessedness in the New Jerusalem. But the meek shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace (Psalm 37: 11).
