Scripture Reading before Invocation Prayer: Jeremiah 2: 11 - 13 forsaken the fountain of living water, and hewed them out cisterns, broken cisterns, that can hold no water.

Scripture Lesson: St. John 7: 37 - 39 If any man thirst, let him come unto me and drink.

Those that Hunger and Thirst after righteousness experience a deep desire for personal righteousness, which is proof of the indwelling of the Holy Spirit. (Galatians 4: 1-6) The spirit within us cries Ab'ba, Father; which means "Father, I will obey you" signifying an intimate relationship and a childlike trust that a young child places in his "Daddy". Our desire of Hunger and Thirst must be earnest and Importunate- persistent almost to the point of annoyance. (Genesis 30: 1, Job 23: 12, Ruth 1: 16-17). Hunger and Thirst are appetites that need frequent replenishing, our inward man needs replenishing as well with fresh supplies of mercy and grace (Ephesians 3: 16, St. John 15: 14-15). To Hunger and Thirst also means to take patiently oppressions and persecutions and commend themselves to God (II Timothy 3: 8-11). Those who Hunger and Thirst after righteousness recognize who's we are and count the cost daily to deny and mortify the flesh (Romans 8: 12-17). We must search ourselves, recognize that we are poor and empty spiritually; and in the depths of this spiritual poverty, hunger, and thirst for that which only Christ can give (Psalm 42: 1-2). Only then can we experience complete fulfillment and satisfaction (Psalm 107: 9). The Bible promises that with Joy shall we draw water out of the well of salvation (Isaiah 12: 1-3).
