#### **Highway to Heaven**

Scripture Reading before Invocation Prayer: II Corinthians 3: 17 – 18 from glory to glory

Scripture Lesson: Psalm 15: 1-5 Who shall abide in thy tabernacle? Personal Purity

Subject: BLESSED ARE THE PURE IN HEART: FOR THEY SHALL SEE GOD.

St. Matthew 5: 8

Text: Psalm 24: 1-5 who shall stand in the holy place, clean hands, and a pure heart.

#### Lesson Outline

I John 3: 1 - 10 at Christ's coming every believer must be pure even as He is pure

True Christianity lies in the heart and the pure in heart is the most comprehensive character of all the beatitudes. The washing of the heart from wickedness (Jeremiah 4: 14). We must lift up to God not only clean hands but a clean heart (Psalm 24: 4-5, I Timothy 1: 5). To be pure in heart we must cleanse ourselves from all the filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God (II Corinthians 7: 1, Psalm 51: 10). For out of the heart come the issues of life (Proverbs 4: 23). For out of the heart proceeded those things which defile us (St. Matthew 15: 15-20). Those who are truly saved shall **see God**; they are the **pure in heart.** Their lives have been transformed by the grace of God. They are not yet sinless (I John 1: 6-10) but their position before God has been changed (I Peter 1: 22-25, II Corinthians 5: 17). They have the New Birth, saving faith, and holiness. The process of sanctification is ever conforming them to the image of Christ (Romans 8: 9), which image consists in "righteousness and true holiness" (Ephesians 4: 20-24).

This beatitude promises that we shall see God, seeing Him as we may by faith in our present state, is heaven on earth; and seeing him as we shall in the future state, is heaven of heaven. The pure in heart have a desire in them which nothing but the sight of God will satisfy. For now we see through a glass darkly; but then face to face.
