Highway to Heaven

Scripture Reading before Invocation Prayer: I Peter 3: 8 – 12 seek Peace and ensue it.

Scripture Lesson: Ephesians 2: 10 – 20 HE is our Peace (cf. Romans 9:4, I Thessalonians 4: 13)

Subject: **BLESSED ARE THE PEACE MAKERS: FOR THEY SHALL BE CALLED THE CHILDREN OF GOD.** (St. Matthew 5: 9) KJV

Text: James 3: 13 - 18 Peacemakers who sow in peace reap a harvest of righteousness

Introduction: Colossians 3: 12 - 15 Ruled by "the government of Peace".

Lesson Outline

- 1. Romans 8: 6 to be spiritually minded is life and peace. (cf. Galatians 5: 22 23 fruit of the spirit)
- 2. Isaiah 26: 3 perfect peace whose mind is stayed on thee (cf. Philippians 4: 6 8 think on these things)
- 3. St. John 14: 27 "My peace I give unto you, not as the world giveth" (cf. I Corinthians 14: 33)
- 4. Ephesians 4: 1-3 unity of the spirit in the bond of peace.

PEACE MAKERS are those who are at peace with God (Romans 5: 1) and desire to live in peace with all men (Hebrews 12: 14). Their peace with Christ enables them to be "ambassadors "of God's message of peace and to carry it to a troubled world. Therefore, they are called the children of God. PEACE MAKERS are those who have a peaceable disposition (Hebrews 12: 14) who love and desire and delight in peace. A peaceable conversation – actively as much as lieth in them they live peaceable with all men (Romans 12: 16 - 18) and avoid conversations or situations that break peace and they try to restore hurtful, and strife-filled conversations or situations. If the peacemakers are blessed woe to the peace-breakers!

Throughout the Beatitudes, Jesus clearly emphasizes that only those who have the qualities of a changed life, (I Thessalonians 5: 22 - 23) as He has exhorted in the Sermon on the Mount will become citizens of His Kingdom and are on the Highway to Heaven (I Thessalonians 5: 22 - 23). Finally, brethren, farewell. Be perfect, be of good comfort, be on one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you (II Corinthians 13: 11).
