Scripture Reading before Invocation Prayer: James 1: 26 – 27

Scripture Lesson: James 1: 21 – 25 (**How to Hear!** You must receive with meekness the engrafted word of God, hear our faults and take it not only patiently but thankfully. The word is wise unto salvation and shows us what is amiss so it can be applied to our lives and lived out daily.)
