## Lack vs Abundance

Scripture Reading before Invocational Prayer: 1 John 3: 8 – 10

Scripture Lesson: Isaiah 14: 12 - 15

Subject: BEWARE CHRISTIANS THAT YOU DON'T ALLOW SATAN TO HAVE YOU FIXATED ON WHAT YOU LACK, BECAUSE THIS WILL BLIND YOU FROM THE ABUNDANCE OF GOD'S BLESSINGS.

Text: Genesis 3: 1-7 fixated on lack instead of abundance.

Introduction: Proverbs 30: 8 - 9 give me neither poverty nor riches.

## **Lesson Outline**

- 1. Genesis 4: 1 − 11 (cf. Hebrews 11: 4, Matthew 23: 35, Luke 11: 50 − 52, 1 John 3: 11- 15). It is a sign of an un-humbled heart to quarrel with those rebukes which by our own sin are brought upon ourselves. It is therefore common for those who rendered themselves unworthy of God's favor to have indignation against those who have received His favor.
- 2. Genesis 25: 27 34 Esau was fixated on his lack and despised the abundance of his birthright.
- 3. Hebrews 13: 5-6 be content with such things as ye have.
- 4. St. Matthew 6: 25 26, (cf. Luke 12: 23) "God feeds the birds, but he doesn't drop it in their nest."
- 5. 1 Timothy 6: 5 8 Godliness with Gratitude is great profit.
- 6. Philippians 4: 12 13 abase or lack and abound or abundance. I'm satisfied with what the Lord gives me.
- 7. Habakkuk 3: 17 18 Yet will I rejoice in the LORD, the God of my salvation.
