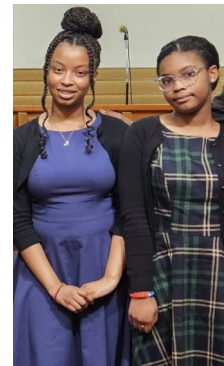

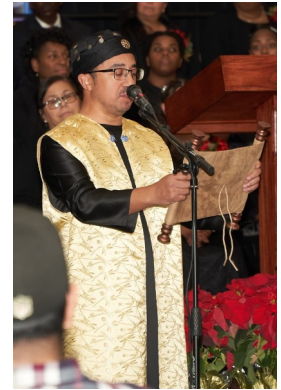
To God Be all Glory!
