THE WILL OF THE FATHER

Scripture Reading before Invocational Prayer: Genesis 22:1-14 God will provide himself a lamb. Exodus 12: 1-14 the Passover Lamb. Isaiah 53:1-12 the LORD hath laid upon him the iniquity of us all. Psalm 22:1-18 My God, my God why hast thou forsaken me? Isaiah 50:6 my cheeks to them that plucked off my hair.

Scripture Lesson: John 4:31-34 The will of the father to love all nations and there by receive greater substance and satisfaction than any mere physical food (cf. Deuteronomy 8:1-3).

Subject: **JESUS SAITH UNTO THEM, MY MEAT IS TO DO THE WILL OF HIM THAT SENT ME, AND TO FINISH HIS WORK**. (John 4:34) KJV

THE WILL OF THE FATHER

- 1. Philippians 2:5-11 The Will of the Father was him to assume human nature. Born to Die.
- 2. Luke 4:18-19 The will of the Father was for him to heal the sick...
- 3. Matthew 5:17-18 The will of the Father was for him to fulfill the law.
- 4. Mark 8:31, Acts 3:18 (cf. Isaiah 53:3-5 The will of the Father that he should suffer reproach.
- 5. John 10:17-18, John 15:13, Acts 2:22-24 The will of the Father was for him to voluntarily offer himself as the "lamb of God (cf. John 1:29 behold the Lamb of God)

Jesus was constant and with great passion as men eat meat with pleasure and refreshing to do the will of the Father. Luke 22: 15 "with desire I have desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer" and again in Romans 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

TO FINISH THE WORK OF THE FATHER

- 6. 2 Corinthians 5:21 To finish the father's work of fulfilling righteousness of the law.
- 7. John 18:37-38 To finish the father's work of bearing witness to the truth.
- 8. Romans 3:23-26, Romans 5:6-9, Romans 6:23 To finish the Father's work of satisfying God's Holy Wrath upon sinners (cf. Luke 2:49 To be about his father's business).
- 9. Luke 4:18, Mark 1:14-15, Matthew 4:17 To finish the father's work of preaching the Gospel.
- 10. John 6:35-40, Luke 19:9-10, 1 John 4:9-10, John 3:16-17, John 14:6, To finish the father's work of saving sinners; not to do his own will.
- 11. Acts 10:38, John 9:1-5 To finish the father's work of healing.
- 12. 2 Corinthians 5:18-21, Ephesians 1:6-7 To finish the father's work of redemption and salvation.
- 13. Hebrews 10:4-14 I come to do thy will, O God. Perfect redemption nothing to be added.
- 14. John 17:1-5 I have finished the work which thou gravest me to do.

Christ's Chief work was to bear the sins of his people and die on the cross. Luke 22:42, John 12:27-28, (Matthew 27:34 vinegar mingled with gall used to deaden the pain) (John 19:28-30 = Psalm 69:21 different drink used) (Matthew 27:46, My God My God) (Matthew 27:50 **YEILDED UP THE GHOST** voluntarily) (John 19:30 **"IT IS FINISHED"**)

"THE ROMANCE OF REDEMPTION"

Jesus perfectly fulfills the will of the Father and finished the work by his perfect sacrifice for mankind. Angels before the throne of God praise Christ's sacrificial love, saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honor, and glory, and blessings (Revelation 5:1-14).
