ADULTS

HIDDEN TREASURES

Scripture Reading before Invocational Prayer: Matthew 13:10-17

Scripture Lesson: 1 Corinthians 2:7-16 Revelation is given to all who **seek** to know. (cf. 1 Peter 2:9-13, a salvation angels desire to look into.)

Subject: **BUT AS IT IS WRITTEN, EYE HATH NOT SEEN, NOR EAR HEARD, NEITHER HAVE ENTERED INTO THE HEART OF MAN, THE THINGS WHICH GOD HATH PREPARED FOR THEM THAT LOVE HIM.** (1 Corinthians 2:9) KJV

Text: Romans 8:1-16 Life in the Spirit is a hidden Treasure that has to be sought out.

Introduction: Matthew 13:44-46 Salvation; a Hidden Treasure valued above all else.

Lesson Outline

1. Proverbs 25:2-3 (cf. Ecclesiastes 3:11, Isaiah 46:9-10, Isaiah 55:8-9, Psalm 145:3, Isaiah 40:28)
2. Hebrews 11:6 a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.
3. Psalm 46:10 Be still, and know that I am God. (Not to panic & recognize His sovereignty.)
4. Isaiah 10:27 The anointing breaks yokes. God in flesh doing what flesh can't do!
5. John 14:16-21 Christ manifested through the spirit. (cf. John 15: 26, 16:7-15)
6. Philippians 3:7-8 counting the cost of a greater Treasure.
7. Romans 11:33-36 O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God.

THE ENGRAFTED WORD A MIRROR FOR THE SOUL

Scripture Reading before Invocation Prayer: James 1:26-27

Scripture Lesson: James 1:21-25 (**How to Hear!** You must receive with meekness the engrafted word of God, hear our faults and take it not only patiently but thankfully. The word is wise unto salvation and shows us what is amiss so it can be applied to our lives and lived out daily.)

Subject: **FOR IF ANY BE A HEARER OF THE WORD, AND NOT A DOER, HE IS LIKE UNTO A MAN BEHOLDING HIS NATURAL FACE IN A GLASS.** (James 1:23)KJV

Text: Luke 6:46-49 (doers build their house on a rock)

Introduction: Matthew 7:21-29 (doers have a sure foundation)

2. Romans 10:14-21 (Ref. Deut. 32:21; Isaiah 65:1-3) **Elects are only saved by believing the word.**
3. 1 Corinthians 2:1-5 (Not with enticing words of man's wisdom)
4. 2 Corinthians 3:1-18 (Beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord)
5. 2 Corinthians 4:1-6 (As open Gospel)
6. 1 Corinthians 13:12 (For now we see through a glass, darkly but then face to face.)
7. 2 Timothy 4:1-8 (For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine)
