Proclaim Liberty – The Year of Jubilee

Scripture Reading before Invocational Prayer: Hebrews 4:12-13 The word discovers our Condition and lets us know to whom we must give account. (It's Living and Powerful)

Scripture Lesson: Leviticus 25:1-28 The Year of Jubilee, 50th year of universal redemption

This year of rest typified the rest that all believers enter into when they accept Christ.

Subject: PROCLAIM LIBERTY THROUGHTOUT ALL THE LAND TO ALL ITS INHABITANTS.

Text: Hebrews 3:7-19

Introduction: Hebrews 4:1-11 The promised Rest (cf. Psalm 95:7-11).

Lesson Outline

- 1. Isaiah 61:1-2; (Luke 4:18-19) True liberty is possible only in a renewed condition of the Soul and cannot exist apart from holiness.
- 2. Galatians 5:1, 11; 1Peter 2:16 (cf. 1 Corinthians 7:20-24)
- 3. John 8:28-36 ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall me you free (cf. Titus 1:1-2; 2 Corinthians 4:15-18).
- 4. Romans 6:17-20 Free from moral corrupt state and the tyranny of sinful lust.
- 5. 2 Peter 2:19 Free from the slavery of corruption.
- 6. Hebrews 2:15 Free and delivered from the fear of death.
- 7. 1 Peter 5:10 Free from imprisonment of the will.
- 8. Revelation 14: 3 that they may rest from their labors and their works do follow them.
- 9. Revelation 5:9 Restitution: the restoration of something lost or stolen to its proper owner.

JUBILEE: means "rams' horn" which was blown on the tenth day of the seventh month (the 10th of Tishrei - Yom Kippur) to start the 50th year of universal redemption and liberty.
