## THE PASSOVER LAMB

Scripture Reading before Invocational Prayer: Matthew 5:17-18; Hebrews 10:1

Scripture Lesson: Exodus 12:1-27 The Passover and the Feast of Unleavened Bread.

Subject: NEW TESTAMENT BELIEVERS, JESUS CHRIST IS OUR PASSOVER LAMB.

Text: John 1:29-36 Behold the Lamb of God.

Introduction: 1 Corinthians 5:1-13 Christ our Passover. The Feast is fellowship with our Passover. The Church should remove anything sinful or leavened or unrepented; even sinful church members (Ephesians 5:1-5, 11; 2 Thessalonians 3:6, 14-15; Matthew 18:15-17; 1 Corinthian 6:1-8; 1 Timothy 5:19-20; Titus 1:7-16, 1 Timothy 1:18-20). The Jews celebrate Passover annually with unleavened bread. The Church celebrates a continual Passover with unleavened lives.

## Lesson Outline

- 1. Luke 22:1-20 The Last Supper or the Lord's Supper was a Passover meal.
- 2. Hebrews 9:1-15 Which was a figure for the time then present
- 3. Hebrews 9:16-28 which are the figures of the true;
- 4. 1 Peter 1:18-25 redeemed by the blood of the Lamb and God's eternal word
- 5. Romans 5:6-9 saved from Wrath through Him
- 6. Revelation 5:1-10 The Resurrection in Eternity; the redeemed in Eternity

Christ in the Lord's Supper was a fulfillment of the Passover, which was a shadow of things to come. It is in observance of the Passover. The Lord's Supper does not replace Passover but rather observes it in our time.
