MARRIAGE AND THE SINGLE LIFE IN CHRIST

Art thou bound unto a wife? Seek not to be loosed. Art thou loosed from a wife? **Seek not a wife? It is good for them if they abide even as I.**

1. 1 Corinthians 7:25-27 present distress; pressure from the world's systems not to submit, the distractions from worldly cares of marriage. The cares of this world refer to the anxieties, worries, and distractions that come with worldly concerns and pursuits. (Mark 4:19) These can hinder spiritual growth and devotion which choke the word of God and prevent it from taking root and producing fruit in a person's life. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.
2. 1 Corinthians 7: 28 if you marry you will have trouble in the flesh; but I spare you. "The excessive desires of a husband for respect and the obsessing desire of a wife for love and security perhaps is some of what the Apostle Paul meant when he said, "but I spare you".
3. 1 Corinthians 7:29-31 time is short the fashions of the world passeth away. We should not love the world more than the things of God (1 John 2:15-17); for he that endures to the end the same shall be saved. (Matthew 24:13) We should all be hasting the coming of the Lord and to see what the end is going to be like. Singleness has many practical advantages and is a Grace of Life and a Gift of God. (1 Thessalonians 4:1-7)
4. 1 Corinthians 7:32-35 preoccupations of marriage make it sometimes necessary to devote endless time to worldly cares. (Luke 10:38-42) but she that is single is free and has the **grace of life** to continue in supplications and prayers night and day. (1 Timothy 5:5)
5. 1 Corinthians 7:36-38 discharge from the father's care, doeth well to keep celibate. If a man finds a wife it's a good thing (Hebrews 13:4, Proverbs 18:22) but he that hath power over his own flesh doeth better.
6. 1 Corinthians 7:39-40 the permanency of marriage, bound by the Law as long as he liveth. (Romans 7:1-3) A spiritual divorce acceptable. 1 Corinthians 7:12-15 not under bondage in such cases; but God hath called us to peace. **May remarry only in the Lord (2 Corinthians 6:14)** But she is happier if she so abide, after my judgement: and I think also that I have the Spirit of God.

Worldly concerns excessively is Sin and God must be attended to without distractions (Matthew 6:25, 33-34, Philippians 4:6-7)
