Scripture Reading before Invocational Prayer: 2 Thessalonians 3:1-5

Scripture Lesson: Deuteronomy 7:6-9 The Faithful God! (cf. Hebrews 13:8)

Subject: **KNOW THEREFORE THAT THE LORD THY GOD, HE IS GOD, THE FAITHFUL GOD, WHICH KEEPETH COVENANT AND MERCY WITH THEM THAT LOVE HIM AND KEEP HIS COMMANDMENTS TO A THOUSAND GENERATIONS.** (Deuteronomy 7:9) KJV

Text: 2 Timothy 2:11-13 Constant faithfulness even when we are unfaithful. Lamentations 3:22-23

Introduction: Numbers 23:19 God is not a man that He should speak and not do.

Lesson Outline

1. Hebrews 6:13-20 God is unchangeable in His Essence, character and promises.
2. 1 Corinthians 10:13 (cf. Hebrews 11:11) God's faithfulness is our assurance.
3. Psalm 119:89-91 (cf. Genesis 8:20-21) unchangeableness of God and His word.

THE FEAR OF THE LORD

The fear of the LORD emphasizes a reverence, an awe and deep respect for God's power and authority, which is the foundation upon which wisdom and understanding are built; and we should live in accordance with His will for our lives. Not a cowardly terror.

Scripture Lesson: Proverbs 1:1-7

Subject: **THE FEAR OF THE LORD IS TO HATE EVIL: PRIDE, AND ARROGANCY, AND THE EVIL WAY, AND THE FROWARD MOUTH DO I HATE.** (Proverbs 8:13) KJV

Text: Proverbs 9:8-11

Introduction: Job 28:28

Lesson Outline

1. Psalm 111:5-10 **The LORD is reverend**; The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom.
2. Psalm 34:9-16 Come ye and I will teach you the fear of the LORD.
3. Matthew 10:24-28 fear him who is able to destroy body and soul in hell.
4. Job 27:8 be not hypocritical for what is the hope of the hypocrite?
5. 1 Peter 5:5-11 humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God
6. Job 22:21-29 Acquaint now thyself or draw nigh by godly sorrow and repentance.
7. Psalm 53:16-17 (cf. Psalm 34:18) a contrite heart is a state of humility where a person recognizes their sin and or wrongdoings and seeks reconciliation, forgiveness and have a willingness to change their ways and turn to God.

SINNERS/UNSAVED TEEN BOYS (13 and older)

Scripture Lesson: Ecclesiastes 1:12-18

Subject: **I HAVE SEEN ALL THE WORKS THAT ARE DONE UNDER THE SUN; AND BEHOLD, ALL IS VANITY AND VEXATION OF SPIRIT.** (Ecclesiastes 1:14) KJV

Text: Ecclesiastes 2:1-11 all was vanity and vexation (frustration, annoyance, irritation, turmoil, and dissatisfaction hopelessness, lack of contentment) of the spirit.

Introduction: Ecclesiastes 2:17-23 chasing the wind; no true joy in possessions

Lesson Outline

1. Ecclesiastes 3:1-11 earthly pursuits are good in their place and time; but unprofitable when pursued as the chief goal. There is a void in all mankind that can only be satisfied by a relationship to our Creator; for God made man with an eternal soul.
2. Ecclesiastes 3:18-21 all living things are subject to the certainty of death.
3. Ecclesiastes 5:10-13 (cf. 1 Timothy 6:6-10)
4. Ecclesiastes 8:6-8,14
5. Luke 16:19-31
6. Ecclesiastes 11:7-10
7. Proverbs 31:30 favor is deceitful, and beauty is vain
