Text: Proverbs 8:1-36 Wisdom was with God from the beginning. (Job 38:1-11)

Introduction: Job 28:1-28 The fear of the LORD that is wisdom. The one who applies his mind to the wisdom of God will understand and gain moral knowledge and the insight to recognize truth. (1 Corinthians 1:18-31)

Lesson Outline

1. Proverbs 3:1-4, 13-26, 33-35 Happy is the man that findeth wisdom and understanding.
2. Proverbs 4:1-7 wisdom the principal thing, and with all thy getting get understanding.
3. Ecclesiastes 7:2-6, 11-12 more wisdom is learned from adversity than from pleasure. True wisdom is developed in our trials and challenges though we wish it were not so. Wisdom provides a fulfilled life better than money.
4. James 1:2-5 if any man lacks wisdom, let him ask of God.
5. James 3:13-18 the difference of earthly wisdom (speculation and philosophy) and heavenly wisdom. (Skillfully applying knowledge to matters of practical living).
