## **PRAYER IS PARTNERSHIP WITH PROVIDENCE**

God's way of letting us in on what He is doing in our lives and the world around us. It aids in helping us to have more of the mind of Christ and our sanctification; as well as builds a deeper relationship with our Heavenly Father.

1. Pray for strength to FIGHT THE GOOD FIGHT, to finish our Course and to Keep the faith.

(Romans 8:26-27 the spirit helpeth our infirmities for we know not what we should pray for as we ought.) (cf. Hebrews 2:17-18; 4:14-16; 7:24-26)

Luke 11:1-13 Importunity – making persistent and bold request to God and continuing until a favorable response is received; earnest and faithful intercession or bold appeal.

2. Pray for newly established Adult class and for their continued growth in grace and the knowledge of Jesus Christ. Pray for our children and ENDEAVOR to prepare them for the future. (2 Peter 1: 15

Luke 18:1-14 WHEN TEMPTED TO GIVE UP; WILL YOU GIVE UP BEFORE CHRIST RETURNS?  
We are to always pray and not to faint. Justice has its source in God; His promises are ours by right and we have a right to ask for them.

3. Pray for the Christian Marriage which is styled after Christ's love for His Church.
