The Feast of Tabernacles

Scripture Reading before Invocational Prayer: John 8:10-12 a divine presence and provision.

Scripture Lesson: John 7:1-53 In the last day, that great day of the feast. "If any man thirst"

Subject: **JESUS' PUBLIC INVITATION DURING THE FEAST OF TABERNACLES FOR ANYONE WHO THIRSTS TO COME TO HIM AND DRINK.**

Text: Deuteronomy 8:1-6 thy raiment waxed not old, these forty years. (cf. Deuteronomy 29:1-6)

Introduction: Nehemiah 8:14-18 dwelling in booths during the feast of Tabernacles

Lesson Outline

1. Nehemiah 9:6-21 God did not choose Israel to show that they were great but rather to show His greatness, His kindness and His tender mercies. (cf. Psalm 36:1-10)
2. John 4:7-15 a well of water springing up into everlasting life.
3. Isaiah 55:1-3 everyone that thirsteth come ye to the waters.
4. Isaiah 43:16-21 (cf. Isaiah 48:20-21; 1 Corinthians 10:4)
5. Isaiah 12:1-6 water out of the wells of salvation
6. Revelation 22:12-17 and let him that is athirst come.
7. Zechariah 14:16-19 Feast of Tabernacles celebrated beginning in the Millennium
8. Revelation 21:1-3 the tabernacle of God is with men.

Thirst means a spiritual need; Living waters is the Holy Spirit and true fulfillment; River is believers becoming a blessing to the world.

Feast of Tabernacles teaches us to Trust in obedience and emphasizes daily dependence in God's faithfulness.
