The significance of Foot Washing

Scripture Reading before Invocational Prayer: Mark 12:28-34 The Great Commandment

Scripture Lesson: Matthew 20:20-28 the Disciples had indignation

Subject: **IF I THEN, YOUR LORD AND MASTER, HAVE WASHED YOUR FEET; YE ALSO OUGHT TO WASH ONE ANOTHER'S FEET.** (John 13:14) KJV

Text: Luke 22:24-27 the Disciples had strife among them, which was the greatest.

Introduction: John 13:3-17 Jesus washes the Disciples feet; for Him it was a display of humility and servanthood in forgiving sinners before His crucifixion. For us it's a symbol of selfless love and humility and caring for one another; it also symbolizes a cleansing and purification from sins which stains the Christians' life along life's journey (1 John 1:6-10); which is the sanctification process. There is worldly spiritual filth that clings to us and that needs to be washed away; the foot washing symbolizes that.

Lesson Outline

1. Mark 10:42-45 true greatness through humility and serving others.
2. Isaiah 53:1-12 The Suffering Servant
3. Philippians 2:1-12 let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus.
4. Ephesians 5:26 washing of the water by the word. (cf. 2 Timothy 3:14-17)
5. Titus 3:1-11 Why come to Church? To wash away the stain of sin and to promote the sanctification process through the word by the Spirit. To Avoid Contentions and to prevent itching ears. (2 Timothy 4:1-5)
6. Colossians 3:12-13 forgiving one another is a service one to another. (cf. 1 Timothy 5:9-10)
7. Galatians 5:13-15 but by love serve one another (cf. 1 Peter 4:10)
