Scripture Readings before Invocational Prayer: Romans 11:1-5, 26-28

Ephesians 2:11-14, 19-20

THE ESTABLISHMENT AND SIGNIFICANCE OF THE NEW COVENANT

THE ORIGIN AND ANNUNCIATION – The act of announcing

Jeremiah 31:31-34 Behold the days come.

The Apostle Paul echoes these same truths in Hebrews 8:6-13

John 1:17 For the law was given by Moses but Grace and Truth came by Jesus Christ.

Hebrews 9:1-9 The First Covenant

THE INAUGURATION – a ceremony to mark the beginning of something.

Matthew 26:26-28 (cf. Luke 22:20; 1 Corinthians 10:16; 1 Corinthians 11:23-26; 1 Corinthians 11:23-26)

THE ACTIVATION – Making something active or operative.

Hebrews 9:14-24 (cf. 1 Timothy 2: 5 – 6; Galatians 3: 13 – 18; 1 Peter 1: 18)

APPLICATION - Putting the truths from scripture into practice.

1 John 2:25-29

John 17:1-3

1 John 2:1-8

The New Covenant is a spiritual agreement promised by God to humanity, foretold by prophets and established through Jesus Christ's death on the cross. Unlike the Old Covenant, which was based on Mosaic Law and broken by human failure, the New Covenant provides direct forgiveness of sins, the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, and an intimate, internal knowledge of God for those who believe. Through Jesus, this everlasting covenant offers a renewed spiritual relationship with God, replacing the external regulations of the Old Covenant with the internal transforming power of God's law written on believers' hearts. (2 Corinthians 3: 2 -3)

A DAY TO HONOR ISRAEL

The New Covenant was foretold by prophets.

1. Ezekiel 37:21-28 Restoration, unification, purification
2. Ezekiel 16:1-63 God's Love for Jerusalem, an everlasting Covenant.
3. **The Abrahamic Covenant** is mentioned. (Genesis 12:1-3; 15:4-8; 17:1-6; 22:13-18)
4. Ezekiel 36:24-28 a new heart and a new spirit will I put within you. (Psalm 51:10)
5. Jeremiah 32:37-41 everlasting covenant (cf. Jeremiah 50:4-5)
6. 2 Samuel 7:8-17 **The Davidic Covenant** (cf. Ezekiel 34:23-24; Jeremiah 23:5-8; 30:9; Isaiah 9:6-7; Luke 1:69-70; Matthew 1:1; Luke 1:31-33)
7. Daniel 2:35, 44-45 (cf. Daniel 7:13-14, 27 an everlasting kingdom)
8. Matthew 25:31-34, 40 then shall the King say to them on his right hand.
9. 2 Corinthians 3:16-18 when Israel turns to the Lord the spirit of the Lord is liberty.
10. Micah 5:2 Whose goings forth have been from old, from everlasting.
11. Ezekiel 37:1-14 The valley of dry bones shall live by God's spirit.
12. Jeremiah 30:1-9 The Restoration of Israel
