LESSON OUTLINE

Treasure is a Stewardship of the Christian life:

1 Corinthians 16: 2 – (**PRIORITY GIVING**) Upon the first day of the week- have a plan, do it routinely, do it reverently, a priority of honoring God. “ A ritual of righteousness” “ Giving is a discipline of life” “ Money is your time and your talent converted into currency”

1 Corinthians 16: 2 (**PERSONAL GIVING**) Let every one of you lay by him in store – Personal for each one is to give

1 Corinthians 16: 2 (**PROPORTIONAL GIVING**) As God hath prospered him – find a basis to start from then give as the Lord has prospered. When your income increases don't increase your living but rather increase your giving. Riches can be a blessing or a burden.

1 Corinthians 16: 2 (**PURPOSEFUL GIVING**) that there be no gathering when I come – purpose so they don't have to have special offerings when he come. Put it in a regular offering to eliminate multiple offerings.

1 Corinthians 16: 3 – giving liberality to help the less fortunate.

11 Corinthians 8: 1 – 24 Proof of your love – first gave their own selves to the Lord.

11 Corinthians 9: 6 – 15 Cheerful giving – Law of sowing and reaping Pv. 19:17, Ecc. 11: 1
