### **THE DAY OF THE LORD**

**Scripture Reading Before Invocational Prayer:** St. Matthew 23: 13 – 15

**Scripture Lesson:** Romans 1: 18 – 32

**SUBJECT: FOR THE WRATH OF GOD IS REVEALED FROM HEAVEN AGAINST ALL UNGODLINESS AND UNRIGHTEOUSNESS OF MEN, WHO HOLD THE TRUTH IN UNRIGHTEOUSNESS.** (Romans 1: 18) KJV

**Text:** Psalms 1: 1 – 6 the ungodly shall not stand in the judgement (cf. Psalms 14: 1)

**Introduction:** Revelation 6: 12 – 17 (cf. Acts 17: 31, II Timothy 4: 1, St. John 5: 21 – 23)

#### **Lesson Outline**

1. Joel 1: 15 & 2: 1 – 11 Alas, for the day of the LORD is at hand.
2. Zephaniah 1: 14 – 18 the day of the Lord's wrath. (cf. Revelation 14: 10,11,19)
3. Isaiah 13: 9 – 13 Behold the day of the LORD cometh, wrath and fierce anger.
4. II Peter 2: 1 – 22 to whom the mist of darkness is reserved for ever.
5. Jude 3 – 25 to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever.
6. II Peter 3: 1 – 15 the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night.
7. I Thessalonians 5: 1 – 11 ye are the children of the light not of the darkness.
8. St. Matthew 24: 36 – 51 watch for ye know not the hour your Lord doth come.
9. II Thessalonians 2: 1 – 17 chosen to salvation through sanctification of the spirit and belief of the truth.

The Day of the LORD in the Bible describes a special time when God steps into human history to judge evil, save His people, and show His omnipotent power; and the return of Christ in Judgement. It begins with the Great Tribulation and includes the Second Coming of Christ and the millennial Kingdom.
